



Your Church App: Quick Start

First Baptist Wisner. Sign in, find your church family, and join your class, all from your phone.

Open it at app.fbcwisner.org

No app store, no password. You sign in with your email, and the church app opens right in your phone's web browser. Follow these steps once and you are set.

1 Open the app and sign in

Open your web browser and go to app.fbcwisner.org. Type your email address, then tap **Send me a sign-in email**. There is no password to remember.

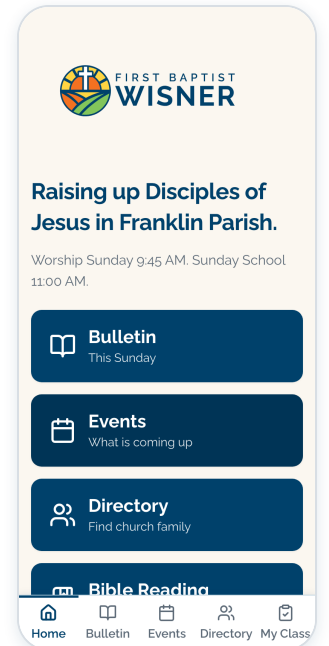
2 Enter your code

Check your email for a message from the church. Tap the sign-in link inside it, or type the 6 numbers into the box and tap **Sign in**. It can take a minute to arrive.

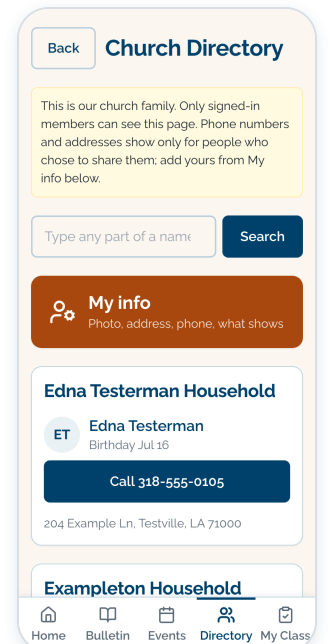
3 You are in

This is your home screen. Tap any card to open it, or use the row of buttons along the bottom: **Home, Bulletin, Events, Directory, My Class.**



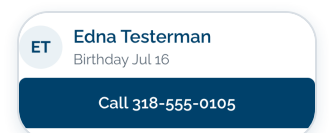
4 Find your church family

Tap **Directory**. Type any part of a name and tap **Search**. Only signed-in members see this page.



5 Call someone with one tap

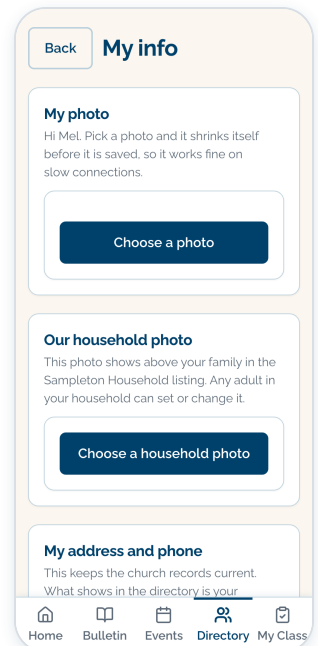
When a person has shared their number, a blue **Call** button shows under their name. Tap it and your phone dials for you.

Add your own information

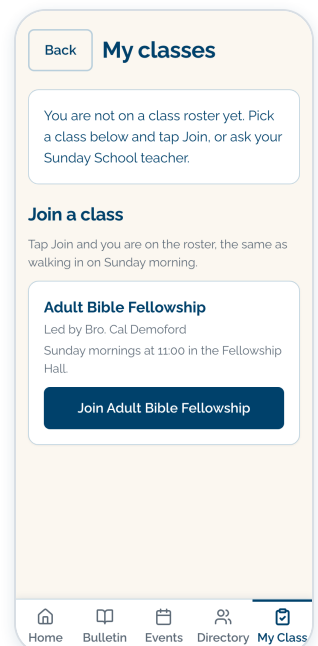
Tap the orange **My info** card. Add your photo, phone, and address. You choose what shows to others and what stays with the office only.

Join your Sunday School class

Tap **My Class**. Find your class under **Join a class** and tap **Join**. You are on the roster, the same as walking in on Sunday.



Put it on your home screen

Add the app once and it opens with one tap, the same as any other app. The First Baptist Wisner icon appears right on your screen.

iPhone (Safari)

- 1 Tap the **Share** button, the square with an up arrow, at the bottom of the screen.
- 2 Scroll down and tap **Add to Home Screen**.
- 3 Tap **Add** in the top corner.

Android (Chrome)

- 1 Tap the **menu**, the three dots, in the top corner.
- 2 Tap **Add to Home screen**, or **Install app**.
- 3 Tap **Add** to confirm.
